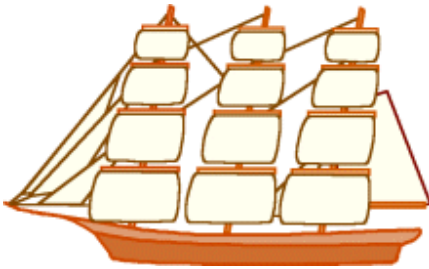


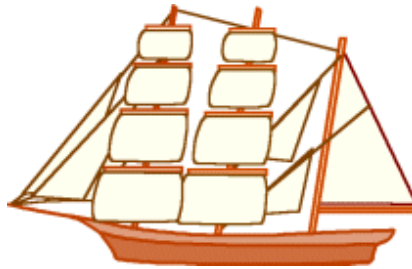

Full-Rigged Ship

3 or more masts.
Square sails on all masts.



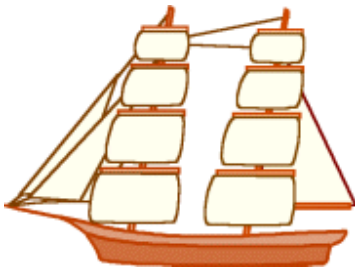
Barque

3 or more masts.
Square sails on first 2 masts only.



Barquentine

3 or more masts.
Square sails on first mast only.



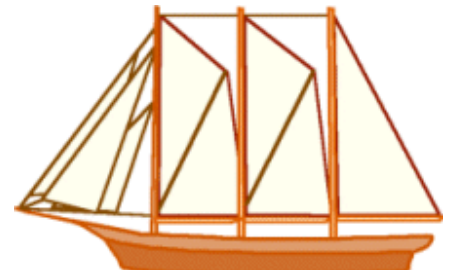
Brig

2 masts only.
Square sails on both masts.



Brigantine

2 masts only.
Square sails on first mast only.



Staysail Schooner

3 or more masts.
No square sails.



Schooner

2 masts only.
No square sails.
Foremast shorter than aftermast.



Ketch

2 masts only.
No square sails.
Foremast taller than aftermast.
Aftermast before rudder.



Yawl

2 masts only.
No square sails.
Foremast taller than aftermast.
Aftermast behind rudder.



Cutter

1 mast only.



Sloop

1 mast only.
